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APPLYING TO LOYOLA

REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's Degree
- U.S. Citizenship, Permanent Residency, or DACA Status
- MCAT
- 30 total BCPM semester credits
 - At least 8 credits in chemistry-based discipline
 - At least 3 credits in organic chemistry
 - At least 8 credits in biology-based discipline
 - At least 1 lab course credit in biology and 1 lab course credit in chemistry
 - Remaining credits may be any combination of courses in biology, chemistry, physics or math. No more than 6 AP credits will be accepted toward remaining total credit requirement

ADMISSIONS TIMELINE

- EARLY JUNE** AMCAS application period opens
- AUG.–FEB.** On-campus interviews with prospective students
- MID-OCT.** First admissions offers are made and continue until class is filled
- EARLY NOV.** AMCAS application deadline
- MID-DEC.** Stritch supplemental application and letters of recommendation due

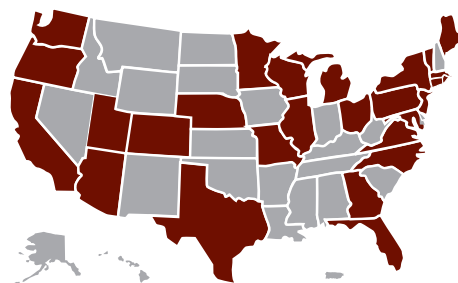

SPECIAL OPPORTUNITIES

STUDENT TRAINING IN APPROACHES TO RESEARCH (STAR)

During this funded, eight-week summer research education program, participants work with a research mentor of their choice.

IGNATIUS SERVICE IMMERSION

Grounded in social justice, this program uses interdisciplinary global service immersion to introduce students to the resources and needs of underserved communities domestically and abroad.

HEALER'S ART ELECTIVE

This course explores and reinforces the human dimensions of medicine through small groups of students and faculty.

MEDICAL SPANISH AND MEDICAL POLISH PROGRAMS

These student-founded elective courses teach students to communicate with non-English speaking patients in a health care setting.

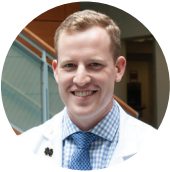
PHYSICIAN'S VOCATION PROGRAM (PVP)

This multi-year elective program allows students to explore ones' self-identity at the intersection of faith and medicine.

TRANSCENDENTAL MEDITATION

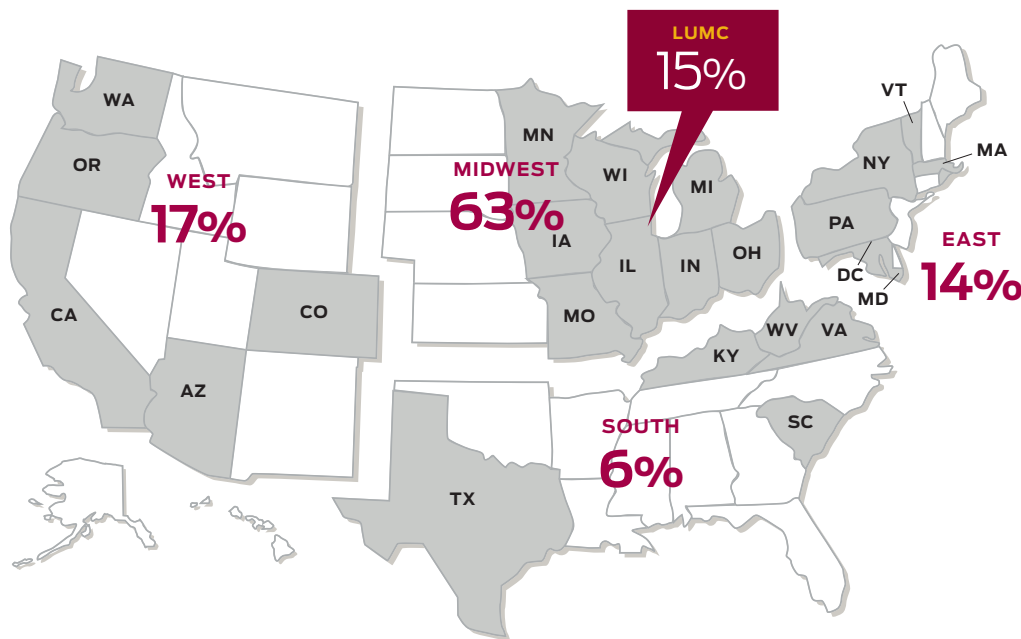
