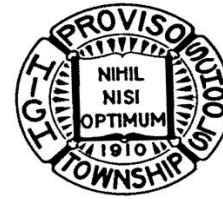

PULSE Session Schedule

- Oct 3 **PULSE Kickoff / Medical School Tour**
3:30-5:00 Students will tour the Stritch School of Medicine. They will also visit the anatomy lab and have an introduction to the stimulation lab
- Nov 7 **Cardiovascular Medicine**
3:30-5:00 Students will be introduced to cardiovascular medicine, as well as learn how to take blood pressure and how to use a stethoscope. Students will also discuss common medical conditions such strokes and heart attacks.
- Nov 7 **Panel Discussion**
3:30-5:00 An interactive Q&A session where Loyola students will describe their paths to medical school and answer questions about college, medical school, and financial aid.
- Dec 6 **Suturing Clinic**
3:30-5:00 Students will learn about common surgical procedures and participate in an interactive suturing workshop.
- Jan 23 **Sports Medicine**
3:30-5:00 An introduction to orthopedics and common sports injuries such as rotator cuff, ACLs, and the difference between a strain and sprain. The student will use models and cadavers to learn the location of these injuries, how they limit mobility, and corrective medical procedures.
- Feb 13 **ER**
3:30-5:00 An introduction to emergency medicine, with Dr. Mark Cichon. Students will experience life as an ER doctor, and a mock patient workup. Students will also participate in an interactive CPR clinic.
