#### 2. How to get reimbursed

- a. Must pay out-of-pocket, then **submit paperwork to Tooba** within **2 WEEKS** after the event
- b. Place your <u>itemized</u> receipt, W-9 form, and reimbursement form (found on the MSU website) in dePorres 261 mailbox
  - (1) Purchases are **TAX EXEMPT** Alia and Tooba have copies of the form to take to the vendor. We CANNOT reimburse tax.
  - (2) If you leave a tip: need both a charge receipt and an itemized receipt
    - (a) Can't tip more than 20%
- c. Reimbursement comes from Lakeshore campus and can take up to 2-6 weeks
- d. Please submit paperwork for your final funding requests for this year by May 17th
- 3. If you already spent your \$100, you can request additional funds through the Additional MSU Funding Request Form on the MSU website
  - a. **Must submit request <u>prior</u> to the event**, cannot be done retroactively
  - b. Form must be completed <u>BEFORE 12pm</u> on the day of the MSU meeting to be considered for approval. It will be added to the MSU meeting agenda and all meeting attendees will vote on it.
  - c. To be funded, events must be open to everyone in the Stritch community, and org must have attempted to fundraise first
    - (1) Student orgs must use/request the initial \$100 first, as well as use any fundraised money, prior to asking for additional funds

- 1. Must register by Sunday, April 21st at 11:59pm to receive funding for upcoming year

- 3. Failing to do so will make you ineligible to receive funding until Jan 1, 2020
