### MSU Meeting Minutes April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020

#### I. Reports from MSU Officers

#### A. President: Kaitlyn Rewis

- 1. MSU Feedback Form
  - a. Student Org leadership application process is overwhelming will continue to have transitions/applications through MSU to try to keep all the student organization processes' standardized and in parallel with each other, but will work on ways to streamline this
- 2. Student Org Transitions
  - a. <u>New Leadership Registration Form</u> deadline extended to Friday, April 17<sup>th</sup> at 11:59pm. All student organizations are required to fill this out (both MSU-funded and non-MSU-funded organizations)
    - (1) Required to fill out if you want to receive funding for the upcoming year, update your website information, or to be able to reserve a table at the Student Org Fair in the Fall (see Kaitlyn's email from 4/3 for details).
    - (2) Please confirm with your board members that everyone is adherent to the student life rule. Catherine will be using this google form to ensure everyone is following the rules and will check again with the information submitted through the official LUC registration form.
    - (3) <u>If a board member is forced to step down after April 17th, we will not allow</u> <u>applications to be reopened and you will not be able to fill that officer position.</u>
  - b. There will be an Official LUC Student Registration Form sent out by the school in July. Student organizations are required to fill out <u>both</u> the Google Form sent out by MSU (due April 17<sup>th</sup>) and the Registration Form from the school (in July).
    - Normally, the official registration form is sent out now, but due to upcoming changes to their website and software, they will not be sending it out until July. Hence, MSU board is sending out the Google form to collect preliminary information and verify adherence to the leadership rule.
  - c. For orgs that are having trouble filling their boards, please reach out to MSU
    - (1) MSU will organize a form to send out early next week (April 13<sup>th</sup>) for orgs having trouble filling their boards - you can submit a bio about your org, the position(s) that need(s) to be filled, and an application link
    - (2) Orgs that need to re-submit applications next week are still required to fill their boards and submit leadership information by Friday, April 17th at 11:59pm.

### 3. Leadership Cap

- a. Max of 1 president position (includes: president, director, co-president, co-director)
- b. Appeal to Catherine Jardien for three positions: <u>3rd position must be as an MSU Rep</u>

### 4. Reimbursements

- a. Remainder of gym membership fee will be reimbursed through LOCUS
- b. Discounted parking passes for 2020-2021 academic year still being discussed
- c. Tuition reimbursements are still being discussed by higher-ups. Dean Gruner is talking with the President of the University, as this is a decision that has to be made

by her.

### 6. Incoming M1 Class

- a. Second Look Day: Wednesday, April  $15^{th}$
- b. M1 orientation: July  $27^{th}$ - $31^{st}$  restructuring to be less compact
- c. White coat ceremony: Saturday, Aug.  $1^{st}$ 
  - Based on feedback from earlier years of how difficult it was to study for class while also spending time with family and friends, admissions decided to have White Coat at the end of M1 orientation before school starts.

# 2. 2020-2021 MSU Projects

- a. Wellness more opportunities; work on restructuring curriculum
  - (1) We will be speaking with the Deans and course directors and provide student feedback
- b. Mentorship
  - (1) Streamline info available to M1s during orientation through a packet with FAQs, advice, and tips. Collaborating with AMIG on this project.
  - (2) M1-M4 families. This will be on a voluntary basis, and we will send out a form soon. The aim is to help students get mentored from both above and below. You can request for a mentor from a class above you and/or request for a mentee from a class below you. A form will be sent out to M1s before orientation starts.
    - (a) Based on this information, we will put everyone who wants to participate into mentoring families.

# C. Secretary: Jesse Webb

- 1. MSU Attendance
  - a. A representative from each student org must attend/sign-in at MSU meetings to receive funding and stay active as an org absences on more than TWO occasions can result in loss of funding
    - (1) Class Boards
      - (a) The M1 and M2 Classes must have 4 members of their board present. The M3 and M4 Classes must have 1 member of their board present.
    - (2) Student Orgs
      - (a) Must have at least one member from the board present

- b. One student can represent up to 2 orgs/boards at each MSU meeting
- 2. **LUCentral** new platform for orgs to submit funding requests, provide org info, calendar of events
  - a. Official registration for this will take place in mid-late July
- 3. Student Org Leadership Summit will take place in August for new org leadership
  - a. This will be required for all org leaders, even if you have attended a Leadership Summit in the past. Since we are transitioning to LUCentral, there will be a lot of new information (i.e. how to request funding, reserving rooms, updating event calendar, etc.)
- 4. MSU Feedback Form is linked at the bottom of every MSU email. Please use it!
- 5. CITE Committee
  - a. If you have any technology/curriculum-related concerns, please submit them via the Curriculum and Technology Feedback Form

### D. Treasurer: Teresa Cheng

- 1. **\$100 per student org**, which is automatically granted if you do the necessary paperwork
  - a. Does NOT roll over to next year, can be used until June 1st
  - b. Funds not spent will be allocated toward SSOM improvements (see below)
- If you already spent your \$100, you can request additional funds through the <u>Additional</u> <u>MSU Funding Request Form</u> on the MSU website
  - a. Must submit request prior to the event, cannot be done retroactively
  - b. Form must be completed <u>BEFORE 12pm</u> on the day of the MSU meeting to be considered for approval. It will be added to the MSU meeting agenda and all meeting attendees will vote on it.
  - c. To be funded, events must be open to everyone in the Stritch community, and org must have attempted to fundraise first
    - (1) Student orgs must use/request the initial \$100 first, as well as use any fundraised money, prior to asking for additional funds
- 3. MSU Funds that are left over will be used to purchase the following things:
  - a. New TV and Keurig for the SAC
  - b. Funds will be transferred to ACE to help purchase Step study resources for current M1s, M2s, and M3s. Class Presidents will be submitting a list of items to be approved by this Friday.
    - (1) There are not enough funds to subsidize study resources for every student. Instead, it will help discount the items being purchased for students.
  - c. Donation to the M4 class gift Student Food Pantry
- 4. Any money from organizations that have not spent their full \$100 will be automatically rolled over to help purchase the above items.
  - a. Teresa will be sending out an email to all organizations who still have funds remaining. If you intend to use your \$100 before June 1st, please indicate so via that email.
