 - (a) Can also be used to advertise events and avoid double booking
- 3. Fall 2021: Do not host events before the Student Org Fair which typically takes place after their first exam.
- 4. Email Etiquette
 - a. Only email your org's member listserv (NOT across all 4 classes or the entire school). Student orgs should generally not be using class listservs.
 - b. Student orgs may utilize class listservs ONLY to promote fundraisers, as long as the fundraiser pertains to all students
 - c. You may utilize unofficial channels to promote events/fundraisers as you see fit (FB groups, Groupme, etc.).
 - d. Please add on to existing listservs from the previous academic year
