Thanks for your email and I hope you are well.

After clicking that link it will provide a budget breakdown of your fall and spring charges and other estimated budget items. Together these charges (tuition and mandatory fees) and estimated budget items makeup your cost of attendance.

Regarding how the money is spent from your tuition dollars is a combination of supporting operational investments that allow Loyola to continue delivering high quality education to students, strengthening student services, academics, and faculty recruitment and retention.
