1. MSU Feedback Form

a. Student Org Leadership

 - (a) Remember, leadership roles can be restructured and no particular positions within an org are required (only requirement for orgs to stay active is to have at least two board members and five active, non-board members)

- (1) Presentations and Student Handbook for M1s will be readily made available online
- (2) M2-M4 Orientation materials will also be available for referencing online

c. SSOM Administration Communication

e. Other Concerns

- (1) STEP 1 The Deans met with M2s on Friday addressing concerns in a Town Hall
 - (a) Deans are encouraging M2s to sit for STEP 1 as soon as they are able to get scheduled due to Stritch curriculum making it optimal to take at the end of M2 year while basic science material is still fresh
 - (b) If you have any questions, please directly contact the Deans
- (2) **Re-signing leases for the fall** the decision to resume school in-person for the Fall vs. continue online education is still in discussion and at the discretion of Governor Pritzker as to when higher education facilities are allowed to resume
 - (a) At this time, no decision has been made on whether we will be returning for classes in the Fall, but the Deans will update us as soon as they know whether it is safe to do so
 - (b) Deans will contact the heads of research honors and global health honors and report back addressing our concerns with the summer changes
