I. MSU Board

A. President: Ryan Mack

1. MSU Feedback Form

a. Thank you for using the form! Please continue to use it for any questions, concerns, or ideas that you'd like us to address at MSU meetings and in our meetings with the Deans.

2. Noise Concerns in Quiet Spaces

a. We passed on concerns about conversations in quiet spaces to the Deans. If there are still no improvements, please continue to let us know through the feedback form.

3. Noise Concerns in CAL Lab

a. We received feedback about noise/conversations from CAL Lab employee offices that disrupt students' studying. We will bring this up to the Deans tomorrow to pass along to those employees.

4. CCGH/Bioethics Emails

a. We received feedback about receiving too many CCGH and Bioethics emails. We will bring up this issue to the Deans tomorrow to try to limit emails.

5. Building Temperature

a. We received feedback that certain areas in the building are too cold. If this continues to be a major issue, Facilities may be able to adjust temperatures. The average room temperature is usually 72°.

6. M1/M2 Buddy Program

- a. Based on feedback submitted to MSU last month, Student Life has been working with us to establish this program, which will be geared towards mentoring M1s with similar interests.
- b. Curtis has been collecting info from interested M2s on study methods, current academic programs they are participating in, and research and extracurricular involvement.
- c. A similar form for M1s will go out this week.
- d. Curtis will pair M1s and M2s based on similar interests in the next few weeks.

7. A Ω A Service Leadership Project Grant

- a. This three-year grant funds three medical schools each year that develop a program aimed at furthering medical student leadership, mentorship, and engagement within underserved communities. We have been meeting with Deans, administration, and faculty to develop the application for this grant, which will include a curriculum for a new program at Loyola to foster student leadership and wellness within Stritch and become more deeply involved in local community engagement and advocacy. - b. We are looking for students from various classes to be involved in the rigorous application process. We will work alongside admin and faculty to further develop the curriculum and complete the various aspects of the application.
